Any and all bed sheets or covers, chair cushions, written documents, letters, notes which would establish who owns or occupies the residence at 4130 Oak Park, SE, Apt. 204, Grand Rapids, videos, sex paraphernalia, VCR, sex videos, TV, photographs of the residence, any and all evidence of pedophilia, and anything left behind by the victim. Also any adult female undergarments. Finally, blood, saliva, head and pubic hair of Daniel Arthur Turner and Stephen Dennis Turner extracted by authorized medical personnel under medically acceptable procedures.

The following facts having been sworn to by affiant in support of the issuance of this Warrant:

Your Affiant is a Grand Rapids Police Detective investigating an abduction and sexual assault on an eleven (11) year old victim, Lakeysha Cage, B/F, DOB: 3-16-83. Lakeysha informed officers that an adult white male abducted her from her yard and carried her to his apartment #204. There the male removed her clothes and sexually assaulted her. She also describes the male urinating on her. She stated that this occurred in the bedroom and livingroom. This man was wearing lipstick.

Another male joined the first male and held Lakeysha down while the first male laid on top of her. Eventually, the man with the lipstick told her to leave and threatened to kill her if she told.

Lakeysha left the apartment and within a half hour told her mother, Cynthia Marble, what happened. Larry Marble, Lakeysha's father went to get a crowbar and Cynthia went to 4130 Oak Park SE, Apt. 204, Grand Rapids, Michigan, and confronted the man wearing lipstick. This man was later identified as Daniel Arthur Turner, W/M, DOB: 9-14-57. The second male was later identified as Stephen Dennis Turner, W/M, DOB: 12-20-62. When she asked him why he raped her daughter, Daniel put his hands up and stated, "I don't know why." Larry appeared at the scene with a crowbar and Daniel immediately shut his door and locked them out. Larry started beating the door with the crowbar and a neighbor called the police about the disturbance.

Paul Mesman and Mike Baar from Grand Rapids Police Department were dispatched to the scene. Officer Baar talked with both men inside the apartment. These men matched the descriptions given by Lakeysha of her attackers. Daniel immediately said to the officers, "You may as well take me now." Both suspects were arrested at the scene. While the suspects were seated in the patrol car, Lakeysha identified them as being her assailants. Lakeysha was taken to St. Mary's hospital where vaginal swabs and other evidence was collected. The scene has been preserved by Grand Rapids Police Department officers watching the address since the dispatch.

Affiant is aware through training and experience in investigating criminal sexual conduct cases, that seminal and other body fluids can be compared with the victim and suspects' blood, saliva, head and pubic hairs are necessary for comparison with vaginal swabs taken from the victim and the bedsheets, covers, and chair cushions.


